

Recent studies have demonstrated that AHA products can be used in specific skin care programs to combat:

- Acne
- Dry skin
- Sun damaged skin
- Blotchy pigmentation
- Fine wrinkles

AHAs work by stimulating new growth of skin and collagen by decreasing the bond that holds dead skin cells on the surface. This allows dead cells to be removed gradually, leaving behind a layer of smoother and softer skin. AHAs also help to unclog pores, thus decreasing the tendency for acne to develop! During an AHA peel, a solution of glycolic acid is applied to your skin for a brief period of time, and then washed away. This solution causes several of the top skin layers to dry up and peel off gradually over a period of several days. When the older layers have peeled off, they expose a new layer of undamaged skin.

Sun alert: This product contains an alpha hydroxy acid (AHA), which may increase your skin's sensitivity to the sun and particularly the possibility of sunburn.

Because this product may make your skin more sensitive to the sun, be certain you have adequate sunscreen protection while using this product and for a week after you discontinue use.

Limiting sun exposure, wearing protective clothing, and using sunscreens may reduce the risks of skin aging, skin cancer, and other harmful effects of the sun.

Important Information About your GLYCOLIC ACID

Thank you so much for your purchase of this Glycolic Acid.

We think you'll be very pleased with this product when you use it correctly.

It is important to read and follow the directions, and pay special attention to the "Notes" section here.

As with any product, on very rare occasions, high sensitivity to Glycolic acid could cause a reaction. Before using any new product on your skin, you must first perform a "patch test"; to be sure you do not have problems later. First, perform a patch test on your wrist and then on a dime-sized area of your facial skin. After your patch test, please wait at least five minutes before you apply the Glycolic Acid to the rest of your face. Proceed with caution.

Application:

For best results, perform a series of 6 peels, one per week for six weeks, pause for 2 weeks... then start again.

Directions:

1. Degrease your skin with an oil-free cleanser.
 2. Rinse well and *gently* pat or air dry.
 3. Gently apply* enough product to nicely cover the area.
 4. Keep product away from eyes, lips, and mucous membranes.
 5. Do NOT rub into skin.
 6. Leave on 1 - 3 minutes. You may increase by a minute a week, up to a maximum of 10 minutes.
 7. Neutralize with a pinch of baking soda and a few drops of water.
 8. Wait 1 minute, and then repeat the neutralizer.
 9. Rinse well with lots of lukewarm water.
 10. Apply your favorite non-comedogenic moisturizer. Add a sunscreen during the day.
- If you do not yet have the Fan Brush, you may use your fingertips.

Notes:

- ❖ Some stinging may occur in people with sensitive skin. Use with *caution*.
- ❖ If burning is severe, discontinue use.
- ❖ This product is not for use by or on pregnant or lactating women.
- ❖ During application, if inflamed areas are stinging, apply liquid soap with a Q-Tip.
- ❖ Do not use any other product containing AHA within 24 hours of your skin peel.
- ❖ Keep the container tightly closed and out of the reach of children.
